

NAYC Discussion

- Safe Sport, non-FEI Championships, qualification changes and more parent engagement for logistics (Housing, food, transportation, supervising, etc)
- Travel Policy Modifications as a result of Safe Sport
- Selection must be based on performance and subjective like sportsmanship, fundraising, etc can only be used when competition record are equal.
- Qualifications - YRCCIO-S *** same as last year. JR CCI ** 2019 – will not require a CCI**-L to qualify. Dressage is a 45 this year not a 50 (2018 50 in Dressage was okay)
- We may be able to send more INDIVIDUALS than 2 depending on the number of entries as a whole
- This will continue to be a National Championship – not a FEI Championship

- Feedback from 2018
 - Transportation, Housing, Food were an issue
 - Coach and Chef missed the chef meeting
 - Sportsmanship (golf cart stolen) and excessive cheering at dressage (spooking) other ring
 - Prep – was too early. No XC School at USET
 - Multiple Coaches where present
 - Mikaela Kantorowski was a great (VOLUNTEER) chef she attended as a rider and groom in prior years
 - Would like to have something for riders 18-21 that is not Intermediate (CIC***)

2019 Actions for Consideration

- Prep at Loch Moy with WoW Camp to reduce cost of facilities and add XC and bring the two programs closer together. (\$50/horse/day plus stabling)
- Request for additional Spring Preps Emma Ford, Holly Hudspeth, Pam Wiedemann, Phyllis Dawson, and Holly Payne as part of Observation Trials
- Area Selection Committee for USEF and USEA Grants and the NAYC (when needed) Holly Hudspeth, Erin Sylvester, Melissa Stubenberg
- Fundraising Dinners at local restaurants that offer kickback at “over night” events
- Sending a Classic 3-Day YR Training team (21 and under)
- 2019 – Chef is mandatory Role. Proposing Donovan, Kantorowski, and Covey at \$1000 plus expenses.
- 2019 – Coach Contract will be floated in March
- Not Covered Expenses – Airfare for Rider and Grooms
- Maybe Housing and Transportation if the Riders stay with family and take on a groom too.
