



Eventing Youth Team Challenge Point System

Team & Individual results must be sent to the USEF Eventing Staff 24 hours after the completion of the Event. All results will count towards the final classification. The final classification of the Series will be made by accumulation of the points obtained in each Team Challenge Eventing Competition according to the points scale below.

Short Format Point System:

Placing	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	13

Long Format Point System:

In case of a tie in the final classification, the tie will be decided in favor of the Area that has participated in a greater number of Events. If the tie remains, for all Competitions for which the team results count, the individual placing of the best three team members will be added using an additional 1000 points for any Athlete not having completed the Competition. The tie will be decided in favor of the Area with the lower of such totals.

If an Area has more than one Team participating in a Team Challenge then the Area must declare in writing to USEF Eventing Staff which Team will earn points towards the final classification prior to the start of competition.

PARTICIPATION

Team: The Teams will be composed of 3 or 4 Athletes from the same Area. The 3 best results of each Area Team will be taken into account for the Team classification.

Individuals: There is no limit to the number of Team Challenge Eventing Events that Athletes / Horses can compete in. Athletes do not have to compete in a short format in order to compete in the long format Championship.

As per FEI rules, if an Athlete competes with several Horses in the Event, his/her Team Horse must start first.

Minimum participation: A minimum of three teams must be entered and compete at each Event of the Series in order to validate the Event as a Team Challenge.

ENTRIES/DRAW OF TEAMS STARTING ORDER:

In accordance to FEI regulations, procedure and time shall be published in the FEI Schedule of the Event.





PRIZE-MONEY / EXPENSES / ENTRY FEES

A specifically dedicated prize giving ceremony will take place at the final Team Challenge Eventing Event. Ribbons and awards will be awarded to the winning Team.

Normal entry fees will apply. It is recommended that no additional entry fee be charged for the Team Challenge Eventing Competition. If charged, the prize money must reflect the additional Team entry fee.

Additional Requirements:

If entries warrant, the Team competition should be run as a block, either before or after the Individuals.
